cost of living - for paris	<p>Thanks to the student card, given upon arrival, students have access to lots of discounts in and around Paris.</p> <p>Housing: rent/month around 1000€*</p> <p>Restaurant: Less than 5€ for a student meal in a University restaurant (CROUS de Paris), with the student card. Around 15€ for a regular meal*.</p> <p>Transportation: one-way ticket (local transport): 2,10€* Navigo pass "Imagine R": 350€* for the academic year, for students under 26 years old. Unlimited travel in Ile-de-France.</p> <p>Leisure: Lots of museums in Paris are free for students under 26 years old, others provide discounts. Students can benefit from interesting discounts for the cinema as well.</p>
